## VINYL & LINO

Ideal for adding low-maintenance, cost-effective style, these are hugely practical – great for kitchens and bathrooms where a wipeable surface is needed. Vinyl is waterproof but lino is the more eco-friendly option and has lost its dated image: quirky designs and bright colours are now widely available for both, along with effective designs that mimic textures such as wood and stone. Try a classic chequerboard look in contrasting colours for a country-style kitchen or splash out with a colourful spot or floral design to add a pretty touch to a country bathroom.

- Lino is biodegradable and doesn't harbour dust or dirt, making it a great choice for asthma sufferers, but it does need sealing against moisture for use in bathrooms.
- Before laying, ensure the subfloor is clean, dry and dust free. For best results, install a layer of plywood on which to fix the vinyl or lino.
